Somers Town Job Hub is an employment service that works in collaboration with employers, training providers, businesses, and partners to deliver an integrated service that helps residents reach their full potential.

The journey for residents can be complex with people needing to overcome multiple barriers. This can lead to confusion and feeling overwhelmed when faced with not knowing where to access the right help and support.

At the Job Hub we can help you overcome those barriers through:

- Job searching and access to vacancies
- Support with CVs and application forms
- Interview skills
- Access to training
- Basic skills, including literacy, numeracy and computers
- Identifying volunteer placements
- Help with clothing for interviews
