Feeling stuck with your job applications, or attending lots of interviews but not getting an offer? We can talk with you about why, and offer feedback and suggestions for how to get 'unstuck'.

## Apprenticeships are for everyone

**Whatever your age, you can apply for apprenticeships.**

They can be a great way to make a start in a brand-new career or return to work after a break – especially because they offer the chance to 'earn as you learn', with the employer paying your salary as well as for you to do a qualification that's relevant to your work.

Summer is typically a busy season for apprenticeships, with more being advertised at this time of year than at any other time. Most of these are for a September or October start. ## 19-24 years old? New opportunities available for you on the Kickstart scheme

**Kickstart is a new scheme designed to encourage employers to offer 6-month paid work experience positions to 19-24 year olds who are not in work, education or employment.**

There are many vacancies being advertised in Camden right now and recent opportunities have included exciting opportunities to gain paid experience in social media management, the fashion industry, writing and editing, events management and more.

## Overcoming barriers

If you are struggling to overcome a particular challenge relating to employment or training, please get in touch and talk to us about it. We can often point you in the direction of an organisation or fund that can help you. This might mean:

- Suitable clothing for a job interview
- Childcare costs while you attend an interview
- A license or accreditation that you need to get work (for example, a SIA license)
- Access to laptops and other technology to get connected
- Help with fees for a course or training that will enable you to gain a qualification that will help you find employment
- Advice on how to set up your own business
- Something else that isn't on this list!

If you are experiencing a barrier to finding work or training, get in touch. There is often more support available than you may realise, and we can help you to find and apply for it as needed.

We can also refer you to other local Camden organisations that can help you with other areas of your life such as managing your finances, staying mentally and physically healthy, understanding benefits, getting legal advice, and more.
